ARTICLE X: MEMBERSHIP DUES

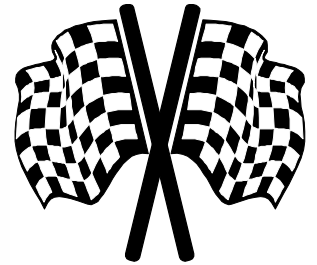
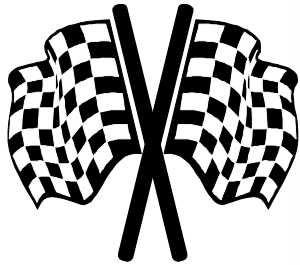
