## A Note From Registration

While it seems like a big hassle to fill out all the insurance paperwork at registration, we don't have a choice on it. Recently, it has been very difficult getting that information filled in correctly. We want to keep your time in registration as short as possible, but the information has to be done right or we have problems after the race.

So, please keep the following points in mind when you are at the registration gatehouse.

1. There are 2 separate insurance forms. Please read the top and fill in the minor report for your children and the adult waiver form for all the adults in your party.
2. Write either "Pit" or "Driver" under the column for duties.
3. Make sure you write in the pit pass number on the form. There isn't a column for it, but it must be on that row with your name.
4. Make sure to put the driver pass number on the driver's line and the spectator pass number on the spectator line.
5. If you are working, don't sign that form put go in and sign the worker list instead.
6. All children under the age of 18 must also sign a minor release. It is good for the whole year if you print clearly and we are able to file it with the insurance provider. If you have a minor with you, sign the minor release or make sure they are on our minor release list already.
